

FAQ SHEET FOR WASHINGTON DC TRIP
OR
(FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS)

Q: Will all 8th grade students attend this trip?

A: The Washington DC trip is a part of the 8th grade curriculum in Social Science, English and Religion. LAB encourages every 8th grade parent to make this trip a priority. In addition to cross-curricular opportunities enhancing student learning, it is a time of interactive learning and exploration that cannot be gleaned from a textbook.

Q: What happens if my child does not go?

A: The 8th grade teaching staff will be on the trip and therefore your child will not be on campus during that time if the decision is made not to attend. Any assignments that students receive on the trip are required of ALL 8th grade students. Those who do not go may use the Internet, library resources, and text books for assistance.
